## THE SELLER AND BUYER AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT:

1. This kitten is purchased as a pet, with no breeding rights. No representation is made by seller regarding the kitten being of show or breeding quality.
2. Buyer agrees to pay a total of \_\_\_\_\_ (\_\_\_\_\_ non-refundable deposit to reserve the kitten and \_\_\_\_\_ balance upon receiving the kitten). This price includes the cost of the kitten, deworming, and the first FVRCP vaccination only. It does not include altering or any other vaccinations.
3. The buyer agrees to have the kitten altered (at buyer's expense) before the kitten is six (6) months of age, and to provide the seller with proof of altering in the form of a report from the licensed veterinarian who performed the procedure. Seller will provide the kittens's TICA breeder slip once proof of altering is received. If the buyer fails to have the kitten altered, seller reserves the right to take possession of the kitten with no payment to the buyer. If buyer is found to be using said kitten as a breeder, a fine of \$2,000.00 will be due to the seller along with the return of the kitten at buyer's expense. Buyer will also be responsible for all attorney fees involved.
4. The kitten has a one year guarantee against fatal genetic or congenital defects. Feline Infectious Peritonitis (FIP) is not covered under this guarantee because it is highly controversial and can be developed regardless of genes. The seller will replace the cat with another kitten as soon as reasonably practical when seller receives proof of defect in the form of a complete autopsy report from a licensed vet, performed at buyer's expense. If seller has no replacement kitten available, a replacement will be given from the next litter with a kitten of equal value. All cats will be replaced with another kitten of like kind and quality. There will be no cash refunds, and buyer is responsible for all medical and shipping costs when replacing a kitten.
5. The cat has a 48 hour guarantee against any serious medical conditions once leaving our home. Buyer is advised to take the kitten (at buyer's expense) to a veterinarian for a complete health check within this period. If the kitten is found to have a serious medical condition, buyer has 48 hours after taking possession of the kitten to notify us and ask for a replacement kitten. This request must be in written form on the letterhead of the examining licensed veterinarian, stating why the kitten's health is in question. We will take the kitten back and provide a replacement. If seller has no replacement kitten available, a replacement will be given from the next litter with a kitten of equal value. If buyer fails to notify seller of said health problems within 48 hours of purchase, buyer will be deemed to have accepted said animal. There will be no cash refunds and buyer is responsible for all medical and shipping costs after purchase.
6. It is recommended that you do not allow your Ragdoll kitten to be given a Feline Leukemia vaccination or FIP vaccination. These vaccinations are controversial and pose too many risks. **This contract will be void if the kitten is given either the Feline Leukemia or FIP vaccination.** Ragdolls are sensitive to vaccines, please do not allow the kitten to be given more than one vaccination at a time, including FVRCP and rabies. **This contract will be void if the kitten is given more than one vaccine at a time.**

7. It is recommended that only the age appropriate core vaccinations be given. Such vaccinations can generally be given at 4 months of age, or at the time the kitten is altered, and include the FVRCP booster vaccine (distemper) and rabies vaccine, although each state has its own laws governing the administration of the rabies vaccine. The seller does not warranty the kitten from any adverse reactions against future vaccines.
8. Buyer also agrees:
  - A. To provide adequate veterinary care and vaccinations.
  - B. To provide a clean environment.
  - C. To never allow the cat to roam freely outdoors.
  - D. Not to place this cat in a shelter or pet shop.
  - E. Not to declaw this cat.
9. Your kitten has been weaned onto Purina Pro Plan kitten food. A sample of this food will be provided by the seller. If you choose not to keep your pet on this food, it is recommended that you mix the sample food you are given with your food of choice, slowly changing the food. Abrupt changes in food can upset your new pet. Seller will not be responsible for complications resulting from incorrect feeding.
10. The seller is not obligated to replace a kitten for any reason, including future health problems, other than those stated in this contract and provided that all terms of the contract are followed.
11. This is a legally binding document. In the event of breech of this agreement, the contract will be void and buyer agrees to pay all reasonable attorney fees and legal expenses as may be allowed by law and incurred by seller in enforcing seller's rights under this agreement. If legal proceedings become necessary, the buyer agrees that all legal and/or court proceedings take place in the state and county in which the seller resides.

Keep in mind that new kittens may show signs of stress including sneezing, runny nose, watery eyes, diarrhea, or constipation when brought into a new environment.
